"Interferometry in an Imperfect World"

I take a critical look at the recent quantum Hall interferometry experiments by the groups of Willett and Kang and examine the possibility that majorana Fermions have been observed. I trust the experimentalist's interpretation of what constitutes a convincing signal, but examine the theoretical standing of the interpretation of this result. The orthodox interpretation of these experiments is excluded and other interpretations are examined.
