

The DVD Discussion App includes a number of undocumented keyboard shortcuts; these shortcuts are useful in controlling DVD playback.

All keyboard shortcuts were discovered through inspection of version 1.0.1102.29331, compiled 1/7/2003. WinDVD 4.0 was the DVD codec on the computer, which may have had something to do with the way keys were interpreted. All keys function when the DVD frame is in focus. I.e., one has to click on the DVD window somewhere first; nothing will happen if one presses these shortcuts when one of the other buttons is in focus.

Keyboard Shortcuts

<i>Key</i>	<i>Function</i>
F	Fullscreen; Windowed (if fullscreen)
P	Play (if paused)
Spacebar	Pause (if playing); “step forward”—advance one frame (if paused)
Esc	Windowed (if fullscreen)
I	GetCurrentVideoAttributes (if playing, displays an info window)
R	Jump to previous scene (if playing)
A	Pause (if playing)
S	Pause (if playing)
N	Jump to next scene (if playing)
M	Menu (if playing)—Note: on many DVDs, it is possible to “resume” or “play film” from the menu, and return to the last play point on the DVD
1	Pause (if playing); “step forward”—advance one frame (if paused)
Home	Menu (if playing)
↓ (NumPad)	Windowed (if fullscreen)
→ (NumPad)	Windowed (if fullscreen)
Home (NumPad)	Menu (if playing)
