- Contracts with outside groups are difficult; Bon Appetit would be able to switch out locations more easily
- Discussion:
- Why can't chains use the meal swipes?
- How would pricing work if you're not on Bon Appetit's meal plan but you eat at the student center?
- Jamba Juice was previously in the student center unsuccessfully
- Game room arcade
- Administrators and grad students probably wouldn't like a Bon Appetit run place
- The goal should be to keep prices similar to how they are now
- There is no reason not to use a chain since they know how to run themselves
- Should we consider adding more food trucks? That doesn't have a 5-year contract issue
- Pricing control should be considered- Verdes raises their prices all the time! Their contract should have a limit
- Prominence of food trucks on campus is a symptom of the bad food options on campus
- People on west campus are concerned with only MacCon available to them
- Charging stations could be beneficial to students
- You can't select vendors that directly compete with each other
- We could speak with Dean Humpfreys to influence potential changes to hours of operation (staying open later)
- Cambridge Grill closes since DD has to stay open at the same time whenever CG is open
